Project Title: Auto/Mobile

Organisation/Applicant: Rita Marcarlo - Instant Dissidence

Award: £1000

Locations: Kirkstall

Date: 22-24 August 2016

A 3-day residency at Burley Children's Centre by dance/performance company Instant Dissidence. This project will feature free workshops for families and multiple performances of the unique interactive family outdoor show in a car.

Project Title: Sunshine and Smiles Family Fun Day
