Round 27 July 2016

Project Title: Alice in Bloomers

Organisation/Applicant: Becky Cherriman

Award: £1000

Locations: City & Hunslet, Morley North

Date: September 2016 – February 2017

Community engagement and research for a 1-woman poetry show about Alice Cliff Scatcherd, a social reformer from Morley. Poet and writer Becky Cherriman will work with Morley local history group and archives to create an exhibition and rehearsed reading at Morley Town Hall and Leeds Central Library. Conditional match funding for Arts Council Award.

Project Title: Land, Sea, Land

Organisation/Applicant: David Bridges

Award: £1000

Locations: Beeston and Holbeck

Date: November 2016 - February 2017

Land, Sea, Land is a series of sculptural film works exploring borders and turning points. Photographic images taken at Cape Wrath, mainland Britain's northern most point, will be projected onto a series of engineered steel and voile forms at Basement Arts in Beeston. Conditional match funding for Arts Council Award.

Project Title: Slow Stream

An interactive video installation in the atrium of the Bexley Wing of St James Hospital. A large video wall will interact with passers-by via embedded web cams to create a series of animated silhouettes. The installation will be in place for 3 months. Conditional match funding for Arts Council Award.

Project Title: Ruido

Locations: Chapel Allerton, Roundhay, Gipton & Harehills, City & Hunslet, Armley, Hyde Park & Woodhouse

Date: October 2016 – February 2017

A dance project exploring communication and language barriers. Dancer Lucy Houghton will work with 7 Leeds groups who experience language barriers to develop a new solo work that will be rehearsed and performed back to the groups at Yorkshire Dance. Conditional match funding for Arts Council Award.

Project Title: Leeds Beer Scene Photography Exhibition
