Project Title: Nightlife at the Flamingo

Organisation/Applicant: Phoenix Dance Theatre

Award: £12,000

Locations: City & Hunslet

Date: June 2016 – November 2016

The original Nightlife at the Flamingo was choreographed by founding member Edward Lynch. The work will be revived and reimaged for Phoenix's 35th Anniversary and performed by a company of 60 including founding dancers, past and current members and the Youth Academy.

Project Title: Fragmented Light Orchestra

Organisation/Applicant: Omni Pictures

Award: £11,600

Locations: City & Hunslet

Date: May 2016 - December 2016

A new interactive Light and Sound sculpture based on the harp instrument but updated using fibre optic light and a responsive synchronised soundscape created by composer Toby Wiltshire. The sculpture can be played by the audience and will respond with light and harmonious sound. The sculpture will be in place for 1 week, potentially including Light Night, enabling a wide audience to interact with it.

Project Title: Caddis – What Will Emerge?

Organisation/Applicant: Playful Anywhere

Award: £13,490

Locations: Armley, Bramley & Stanningley, Kirkstall

Date: May 2016 – August 2016

A canal-based art project creating a Caddis fly larvae-like structure atop a canal barge. Residents and business affected by the 2015 floods will work with artist Gemma Latham and Marie Millward in a series of on and off board arts workshops to explore the communities' responses to the floods.

Locations: Burmantofts & Richmond Hill, Gipton & Harehills, City & Hunslet, Temple Newsam, Crossgates & Whinmoor, Morley North, Rothwell.

Date: May 2016 – October 2016

A trio of Participate commissions for Juncture 2016. Swarm Sculpture by Lucy Suggate will work with 40 individuals to create a new work for a gallery. Dancing on my own by Sara Lindstum will include a week's residency in the Trinity Centre working with 15 individuals to create a new dance film. Assembly by Nicole Conibere will work with 30 performers in a durational live artwork.

Project Title: Think, Play, Do

Date: May 2016 – May 2017

The realisation of a new interactive, family friendly public sculpture outside The Tetley. Six artist proposals have been produced and one will be selected by a panel that includes art specialists and community representatives.

Project Title: 105+dB

Organisation/Applicant: Invisible Flock

Date: January 2016

A large sound installation taking place in Lille and Leeds during Euro 2016. The sounds of the crowd at an LUFC match recorded in spatial detail, will be recreated outdoors in a city centre location with an array of speakers, enabling the audience to immerse themselves in the soundscape of the match.

Project Title: Leeds Waterfront Festival Community Programme

Organisation/Applicant: Canal Connections

Award: £9000

Locations: Armley, Bramley & Stanningley, Kirkstall, City & Hunslet

Date: April 2016 – July 2016

A pre-festival engagement programme to create work to be showcased at the 9th Leeds Waterfront Festival in June. Photography, storytelling, knitting and street art workshops will be delivered in local people living/working near the waterways.





Project Title: Films from Nowhere: Utopian Visions in Leeds

Organisation/Applicant: Lumen

Award: £4000

Locations: Hyde Park & Woodhouse, Chapel Allerton, Armley, City & Hunslet, Guisley & Rawdon

Date: May 2016 – April 2017

A multi-venue community tour screening Films From Nowhere, 60 minutes of short film commissions of artist films exploring what Leeds might be like in the future. The artist films sound-tracked by Leeds bands/artists and the screenings will be accompanied by a live band.

Project Title: Armley Literature Festival

Organisation/Applicant: New Wortley Community Association

Locations: Armley

Date: April 2016 – July 2016

A new writing festival for Armley / New Wortley. Leeds writers / poets and spoken word artists will deliver a series of weekly workshops leading up to a weekend of talks, performances and exhibitions as part of the New Wortley Festival.

Project Title: Leeds Black Music Festival – Talent Development

Organisation/Applicant: Black Health Initiative

Award: £10,000

Locations: Hyde Park & Woodhouse

Date: May 2016 – October 2016

A talent development programme to nurture young performers towards performing at Leeds Black Music Festival. Open auditions will identify a group of young people who will undergo a tailored programme of 1to1 support in performance skills before playing with a live band at the festival.

Project Title: Community Cinema

Organisation/Applicant: Left Bank Leeds

Award: £1500

Locations: Hyde Park & Woodhouse

Date: April 2016 – July 2016

A programme of cultural film and discussion events at Left Bank. Six documentaries about art, music and data paired with speakers or exhibitions to appeal to a wide audience while providing a different kind of community cinema.
