**Project Title: Feet on the Ground**

**Organisation/Applicant: Leeds GATE**

**Award: £11,320**

**Locations: Burmantofts & Richmond Hill, Farnley & Wortley**

**Date: August 2016 – Feb 2017**

A visual art project with the Gypsy and Traveller community in Leeds. A participatory project with artist Delaine Le Bas and Leeds Gate Archivist Vanessa Cardui exploring memories and stories of Leeds Gypsy and Traveller temporary encampments, resulting in an exhibition at Leeds Gate and inside a trailer by Delaine Le Bas.

**Project Title: Music Leeds Us**

**Date: Sept 2016**

LS14Trust and Interplay. The stories will then be worked into a show with original music that will return to be performed in the communities.
