Colin Philpott Media The Last Match	Touring theatre production to Headingley Cricket Stadium of 7 performances of The Last Match, telling the story of Leeds born Hedley Verity and the last cricket match before WWII.	1000
The Gallery at Munro House The Great Edible Art Show	Celebrating BAS8 and reflecting Leeds growing foodie culture, Leeds Gallery will commission and exhibit 4 well known replica artworks, from previous BAS shows, made out of cake. The artworks by Damien Hirst, Tracey Emin, Grayson Perry and Sarah Lucas will be created by artists The Tattooed Bakers, the day will include open access talks about the artists featured and BAS8.	1000
Carriageworks Theatre Free Workshops at the Carriageworks	A day of free performance workshops by Leeds based companies during the Carriageworks 10th Anniversary. Workshops will be delivered by Red Ladder, Interplay, Odd Doll and Paper Birds.	950

Working with The Little Big Band to offer dance workshops followed by a Big Swing Dance event at the newly expanded Morley Arts Festival. SEIZE PASTE	A poster project commissioning 15 local, national and international contemporary artists to create large work to be displayed on poster drums during the opening two weeks of BAS8, accompanied by a map, talk and website of the artworks.	895
Friends of Parkinson's Park Lantern walk	A lantern parade in Parkinson Park in Guiseley organised by local people and preceded by lantern making and drumming workshops.	551
